

About the University

Mahapurusha Srimanta Sankaradeva Viswavidyalaya was formally founded on 10th June, 2014 with 3 constituent Units in Guwahati, Dhubri & Jorhat. Since 2014, the University has been trying to impart value oriented education with humanistic insight in diverse fields of study so that the students can develop themselves to be professionally efficient, socially committed, intellectually competent and morally strong citizens. The University is founded on the sociological ideals of sharing and caring propounded and propagated by Srimanta Sankaradeva a leading personality of Vaishnavite movement in medieval India. Mahapurusha Srimanta Sankaradeva Viswavidyalaya offers undergraduate, post-graduate and research programmes ranging from B.A. to Ph.D. along with Diploma and Certificate programmes in some subjects. Mahapurusha Srimanta Sankaradeva Viswavidyalaya, Nagaon in its first academic session (2014-15) established the Departments of Assamese, Computer Application, Education, Sankaradeva Studies and Sociology. At present the University is enriched with 18 (eighteen) departments. This is the only University in North-East India to have a unique programme i.e. M.Sc./Ph.D. in Cancer Biology to cope with the challenges of cancer in this part of the country. The University is planning to introduce few new departments to offer new programmes. MSSV has also introduced short term, certificate and diploma courses on Palliative Care Social Work, Yoga and other soft skills.

To carry out its mission of quality research work, the University has already launched a Centre for North East Studies which is solely dedicated to scholastic and research based works on unexplored aspects of this crucial geo-political region of the world. It has been resolved that this University would try its best to highlight North East as its focal academic area and the centre is one of these attempts to turn the vision into a reality. The Centre aims to initiate authentic research on the cultural diversity, unique traditions, traditional knowledge system and socio-political happenings of the regions in the form of academic symposia, seminars, publications, workshops, field studies to name a few. The University publishes a biannual research journal, a university magazine, departmental magazines, newsletters and occasional papers by the faculty members of the University. The Central Library of the University has almost twenty thousand books along with a good number of research journals, periodicals and newspapers. The library also provides e-resources through the resources of National Digital Library. Keeping in mind the social responsibility to be fulfilled by a higher educational institution, the University is in the process of adopting villages in the district of Nagaon, for promoting it as a model village.

Govt. of Assam has provided 100 acres of land to establish a permanent campus at Raidongia, Nagaon. Further, the government has given financial support to ensure value based education.



RECOGNITIONS:

(1) Gazette Notification:

The Assam Legislative Assembly passed 'The Mahapurusha Srimanta Sankaradeva Viswavidyalaya Act, 2013'. The Act of the Assam Legislative Assembly (Assam Act No. XIX of 2013) received the assent of the Hon'ble Governor of Assam vide: No. LGL.59/2013/16 and notified it in the Assam Gazette No. 351 dated 14th August, 2013.

(2) Inclusion in the UGC Website:

The University Grants Commission (UGC) vide letter No. F.8-26/2014 (CPP-1/PU) dated 17 December, 2014 informed that "in view of the establishment of Mahapurusha Srimanta Sankaradeva Viswavidyalaya (MSSV), Srimanta Sankaradeva Sangha Complex, Haladhar Bhuyan Path, Kalongpar, Nagaon-782001, Assam by State Act, the name of the University has been included in the list maintained by the UGC on its website www.ugc.ac.in".

(3) Inclusion in AISHE Portal:

The Assistant Director, Department of Higher Education, Ministry of Human Resource Development (vide communication dated, 29th February, 2016) has informed that Mahapurusha Srimanta Sankaradeva Viswavidyalaya has been added as a State University and allotted ID 0812 for All India Survey on Higher Education (AISHE), Ministry of HRD, w.e.f. 2014-15.

(4) 2(f) Recognition:

The University Grants Commission (UGC) has recognised the Mahapurusha Srimanta Sankaradeva Viswavidyalaya (MSSV) under section 2(f) of UGC Act of 1956 vide letter No. F.No.8-8/2019 (CPP-1/PV) dated 20th July, 2020.



(5) Scholarship Portal:

The National Scholarship Portal of the Department of Electronic & Information Technology, Ministry of Communications & IT, Govt. of India has added Mahapurusha Srimanta Sankaradeva Viswavidyalaya in its University Data Base List. Students of MSSV can now apply to various scholarship by maintaining the essential eligibility criteria.

(6) MSSV (Amendment) Act, 2021:

The MSSV Act is amended and consented by the Governor of Assam vide No. LGL. 59/2013/40 dated 24th January, 2022 allowing establishment of 5 constituent units of the University in Guwahati, Jorhat, Dibrugarh, Dhubri and Goalpara.

(7) Govt. of Assam declaration in the Budget 2022-23:

"SI.No.168: Mahapurusha Srimanta Sankaradeva Viswavidyalaya has been striving to impart value-based education harmonizing technical excellence with spiritual and moral values. Recognizing the significance of this university, our Government proposes to provide grants-in-aid support for payment of 75 per cent salary of its faculty members."

(8) Certificate Awarded:

"Certificate of Excellence awarded to Mahapurusha Srimanta Sankaradeva Viswavidyalaya, Nagaon for successfully implementing R10+24 War & Peace-International Decade for the Rapprochement of Cultures IDRC India Programme, Mumbai in 2018-19".



ACADEMIC ASPECTS:

The University in its first academic session (2014-15) established the Departments of Assamese, Computer Application, Education, Sankaradeva Studies and Sociology. The University in its second academic year (2015-16) along with the existing five Departments introduced three other Departments namely, Departments of Juridical Studies, Social Work and Yogic Science. In the academic year (2016-17) the University established the Department of English. In the academic session (2017-18) the University has established a Campus at the Sankari Sanskriti Kendra, Rupnagar, Bhangagarh, Guwahati and shifted the Departments of Juridical Studies, Social Work, Yogic Science to this Campus from the Nagaon main Campus. Besides these, the Department of English was started in the Guwahati Campus too. In Nagaon Campus the University established two new Departments- Philosophy and Economics. In the academic year (2018-19) the University established the Department of Performing Arts at Guwahati Campus. In the academic session 2018-2019 the University started B.A. (Major) at main campus of the University and B.P.A. (Bachelor of Performing Arts), M.A. in Dance, M.A. in Music, M.A. in Drama at Guwahati Campus. In the academic session 2021-2022 the University has decided to start M.Com. at Guwahati Campus of the University. In academic session 2022-23 the university established the Dept. of Computational Biology & Biotechnology, Dept. of Geography, Dept. of Political Science, Mathematics, At present the University is offering Ph.D. programme in the Departments of Assamese, Computational Biology & Biotechnology, Computer Application, Economics, Education, English, Geography, Juridical Studies, Mathematics, North East Studies, Performing Arts, Philosophy, Political Science, Sankaradeva Studies, Social Work, Sociology, Yogic Science & Naturopathy. In the research programmes the University is strictly following the relevant and latest guidelines of the UGC.



INFRASTRUCTURE:

The permanent campus of the University is under construction at Atuatika, Raidongia, Nagaon which is about 11 kms from Nagaon main town. The Govt. of Assam has allotted 300 bighas of land and sanctioned Rs. 15 crores for the permanent campus of the University. The architecture of the permanent campus at Raidongia has been designed in such a way which will showcase the rich art and Sankari Culture of Assam. Academic Programmes will start in permanent campus from 2023-24 Session. At present, the main campus of the University is situated at Srimanta Sankaradeva Sangha Complex, H.B. Road, Kalongpar, Nagaon.

DETAILED ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION TO VARIOUS POSTGRADUATE PROGRAMMES

1. Eligibility for Admission to M.A. Programmes:

Assamese, Economics, Education, English, History, Philosophy, Political Science, Sanskrit, Sociology: These are offered in Choice Based Credit System (CBCS): At least 45% marks in Major in the subject concerned or at least 50% marks in the subject concerned having an aggregate of at least 45% marks in B.A.

2. Eligibility for Admission to M.A. in Performing Arts (Dance / Music / Theatre):

The students after successful completion of First Year (two semesters) and passing the examination shall be awarded PG Diploma and the students who continue in the programme, shall be awarded M.A.in Performing Arts after successful completion of two years (four semesters) and passing the examination.

Eligibility for Admission:

- (i) Candidates who have passed B.P.A. (Bachelor of Performing Arts) or B.A. in Performing Arts from any recognised University with at least 45% marks in aggregate.
- (ii) Graduates of any stream with at least 45% marks in aggregate, having Certificate/ Diploma in the relevant subject (Dance/Music/Theatre) from any recognised institute/institution of repute, in which case the candidates shall have to appear in an interview.

3. M.A./M.Sc. in Yogic Science and Naturopathy:

The students after successful completion of the first year (two semesters) and passing the examinations shall have the option to leave the Programme and in that case they shall be awarded PG Diploma. The students after successful completion of First Year (two semesters) and passing the examination shall be awarded PG Diploma in Yogic Science & Naturopathy and the students who continue in the programme, shall be awarded M.A./M.Sc. in Yogic Science & Naturopathy, after successful completion of two years (four semesters) and passing the examination.

Eligibility for Admission:

- (i) Bachelor Degree holders from a recognised University with at least 45% marks.
- (ii) Must be physically and mentally sound to undergo intense practical training in all yoga practices. A certificate from a competent medical practitioner shall have to be produced at the time of admission.
- (iii) Age of the applicant shall ordinarily be not more than 30 years.
- (iv) Preference shall be given to the candidates having Major in Philosophy/Sanskrit/ Zoology in the first degree.



4. Eligibility for Admission to M.A. in Yogic Science and Human Consciousness:

- (i) Bachelor Degree holders from a recognised University with at least 45% marks.
- (ii) One-year Diploma in Yoga from any recognized University/ Institution.
- (iii) Must be physically and mentally sound to undergo intense practical training in all yoga practices.

5. Eligibility for Admission to M.S.W. (Master of Social Work) (Offered in Choice Based Credit System (CBCS):

- (i) Bachelor's Degree from a recognised University securing at least 45% in Major of any subject or in aggregate.
- (ii) Must be medically fit for doing extensive Field Work. A certificate of physical fitness must be produced at the time of admission.

6. Eligibility for Admission to Mass Communication & Journalism:

At least 45% marks in Major in the subject concerned or at least 50% marks in the subject concerned having on aggregate of at least 45% marks in B.A.

7. Eligibility for Admission to M.Sc. in Mathematics/Geography:

At least 45% marks in Major in the subject concerned having an aggregate of at least 45% marks in preferably in B.Sc./B.Tech./B.E. in any reputed University or Institution.

8. Eligibility for Admission to M.Sc. IT (Machine Learning & Big Data Analytics):

At least 45% marks in Major in the subject concerned having on aggregate of at least 45% marks preferably in B.Sc. in physics, chemistry, mathematics, computer science or any other related specialisation.

9. Eligibility for Admission to LL.M. (Master of Law):

(These are offered in Choice Based Credit System (CBCS):

At least 50% marks (45% for SC/ST/PWD) in LL.B (3 years/ 5years).



10. Eligibility for Admission to M.Com. (Master of Commerce):

B.Com with at least 45% marks in Major in the subject concerned or at least 50% marks in the subject concerned having an aggregate of at least 45% marks in B. Com.

11. Eligibility for Admission to M.Sc. in Bioinformatics:

B.Sc. in Zoology/ Botany/ Biotechnology/ Microbiology/ Biochemistry or any allied field of Biology with 50% marks or 5.0 CGPA.

12. Eligibility for Admission to M.Sc. in Biotechnology:

B.Sc. in Biotechnology/Microbiology/Biochemistry or Biology with 50% marks or 5.0 CGPA.

13. Eligibility for Admission to M.Sc. in Cancer Biology:

B.Sc. in Zoology/ Biotechnology/ Microbiology/ Biochemistry or Biology with 50% marks or 5.0 CGPA.

14. Eligibility for Admission to M.Sc. IT (Machine Learning & Big Data Analytics):

B.Sc./BCA/B.Voc./B.Tech./B.E. with 45% marks.

15. Eligibility for Admission to M.A. in Sanskrit:

At least 45% marks in Major in the subject concerned or at least 50% marks in the subject concerned having an aggregate of at least 45% marks in B.A.



19. Eligibility for Admission to B.A. in Public Administration & Governance:

At least 45% marks or equivalent grade in '10+2' examination (any discipline). Students after successful completion of the first year (two semesters) and passing the examinations shall have the option to leave the Programme and in that case they shall be awarded Certificate in Public Administration & Governance, after successful completion of the second year (four semesters) and passing the examinations shall have the option to leave the programme and in that case they shall be awarded Diploma Public Administration & Governance. The students who continue in the programme, shall be awarded B.A. in Public Administration & Governance, after successful completion of three years (six semesters) and passing the examination. Those who continue for the fourth year (7th & 8th Semester) and on successful completion of the examination shall be awarded B.A. in Public Administration & Governance with Honours/Research.

20. Eligibility for Admission to B.Sc. I.T.:

At least 45% marks or equivalent grade in '10+2' examination (any discipline).

21. Eligibility for Admission to B.Sc. I.T. (Digital Forensics & Cyber Security):

At least 45% marks or equivalent grade in '10+2' examination (any discipline). The students after successful completion of the first year (two semesters) and passing the examinations shall have the option to leave the programme and in that case they shall be awarded Certificate in IT, after successful completion of the second year (four semesters) and passing the examination shall have the option to leave the programme and in that case they shall be awarded Diploma in IT (Digital Forensics & Cyber Security). The students who continue in the programme, shall be awarded B.Sc. IT (Digital Forensics & Cyber Security), after successful completion of three years (six semesters) and passing the examination. Those who continue for the fourth year (7th & 8th Semester) and on successful completion of the examination shall be awarded B.Sc. IT (Digital Forensics & Cyber Security) with Honours/Research.



22. Eligibility for Admission to B.Sc. in Fitness & Athletic Conditioning: Higher Secondary (10+2) Examination. Students after successful completion of the first year (two semesters) and passing the examination shall have the option to leave the programme and in that case they shall be awarded Certificate in Fitness & Athletic Conditioning, after successful completion of the second year (four semesters) and passing the examination shall have the option to leave the programme and in that case they shall be awarded Diploma in Fitness & Athletic Conditioning. The students who continue in the programme, shall be awarded B.Sc. in Fitness & Athletic Conditioning, after successful completion of three years (six semesters) and passing the examination. Those who continue for the fourth year (7th & 8th Semester) and on successful completion of the examination shall be awarded B.Sc. in Fitness & Athletic Conditioning with Honours/Research).

CERTIFICATE/DIPLOMA PROGRAMMES:

- 23. Eligibility for Admission to Post Graduate Diploma in Yogic Science: At least 45% marks in Bachelor Degree in any discipline from any Education Board recognized by the State or Central Govt.
- 24. Eligibility for Admission to Diploma in Design (Digital Marketing, Animation & VFX, Fashion Designing, Integrate Designing):
 Higher Secondary (10+2) Examination.
- 25. Eligibility for Admission to Diploma in Palliative Care Social Work [Certificate /Diploma]:

Bachelor Degree with minimum 45% marks.

Modular Programme: On successful completion of 1 year students will be awarded Certificate in Palliative Care Social Work and those who continue for the 2nd year (3rd & 4th Semester) and on successful completion of the examination shall be awarded Diploma in Palliative Care Social Work.

26. Eligibility for Admission to Part Time Certificate/Diploma in Yoga: Higher Secondary or equivalent in any discipline from any Education Board recognized by the State or Central Govt.

N.B.:

- Semester fee includes admission fee.
- Hostel/PG facility available for Girl students.
- For Subjects with Practical/Laboratory: Additional Fee of Rs. 5000/- (For Science Programme) & Rs. 3000/- (For Arts Programme) per Semester applicable for Semesters having Practical/Laboratory.
- Where the admission is less than 50% of the Intake mentioned above, University may not conduct such programmes.



ADMISSION PROCEDURE

1. ONLINE APPLICATION PROCUDURE:

Interest candidates may apply online by following steps given below:

- a. Visit the University website www.mssv.ac.in
- b. Click on 'Admission 2023-24'
- c. Click on "Student login"
- d. Follow the instructions mentioned in Student login page.
- e. Candidates may also reach the "Student login" page by visiting the webpage: https://webadmin.mssv.ac.in/
- f. Application Fee: Rs. 300/-

2. SELECTION PROCEDURE:

Selection of candidates for admission shall be made on merit basis.

The list of selected candidates shall be put on the Notice Board of the University and the University's website: www.mssv.ac.in. Intimation to the candidates shall not be conveyed individually. The candidates may be called for interview on the date and venue to be decided by the University.

Selected candidates shall have to get themselves admitted on the date & time as specified by the University on payment of the prescribed fee, failing which selection for admission shall automatically get cancelled.

For the programmes offered at different units/campuses, i.e. Nagaon, Guwahati, Jorhat and Dhubri Unit, the list of selected candidates for admission shall be prepared on the basis of the merit separately for the different units/campuses, as per their preference.

3. WAITING LIST:

A waiting list, programme-wise, of the candidates shall be prepared. Candidates in Waiting List may also be called for interview along with the provisionally selected candidates. Vacant seats, if any, shall be filled up from the candidates in the Waiting List. No student from the Waiting List shall, however, be admitted to any programme after 15 days from the date of commencement of classes in a Semester/Session.



4. CANCELLATION OF ADMISSION:

- (i) A candidate shall forfeit his/her seat, if admission is not taken on the specified date.
- (ii) A student shall also forfeit the seat, if he/she fails to attend classes without valid ground and permission of the Head of the Department concerned for consecutive 15 (fifteen) days from the date of commencement of class.
- (iii) The name of the student shall also be struck off the Rolls of the University, if he/she is found admitted to similar programmes at other University / Institution during the academic session in which he/she is admitted in the University.

5. ADMISSION TO NEXT HIGHER SEMESTER/CLASS:

Students of all the programmes on completion of a Semester shall be admitted to next higher Semester/Class on payment of the dues within the prescribed period. They must produce the official receipt of the payment of the dues to the respective Head of the Department for record and to get their names registered in the Department.

6. ATTENDANCE:

All students shall attend a minimum of **85% of the total number of classes held.** Under special circumstances if the percentage of attendance falls below 85% but above 75%, the student may be considered for giving permission to appear in the End Semester Examination on payment of the prescribed fine.

7. RESERVATION AND RELAXATION:

FOR ADMISSION:

(i) Statutory Reservation:

Scheduled Caste (S.C.): 7%

Scheduled Tribes, Plains (S.T.P.): 10% Scheduled Tribes, Hills (S.T.H.): 5%

OBC/MOBC: 15%

EWS 10% from Unreserved.

NOTE: For consideration of admission under reserved categories, Certificates countersigned by the Deputy Commissioner of the district concerned must be produced.



(ii) Differently Abled (PwD):

- 4% of the total seats in each subject/programme shall be reserved for the differently abled candidates.
- Candidates applying for admission under this category of reservation must submit Medical Certificate issued by the Joint Director of Health Services of the district concerned.
- Candidates with negligible deficiency shall not be considered for admission under this category of reservation.

(iii) Extra-Curricular Activities:

(A) SPORTS:

A total of three seats for all the programmes have been reserved for the candidates having proficiency in Extra Curricular activities as shown below. He/she must have represented the State of Assam in any one of the games conducted by the National Sports Federation or Association of Indian Universities (AIU), New Delhi as recognised by the Sports Authority of India (SAI) / Ministry of Human Resource Development, Govt. of India. (1) Athletics (2) Badminton (3) Cricket (4) Football (5) Table Tennis (6) Weight Lifting and Best Physique (7) Volley Ball and any other sports.

The candidates under this category must be below the age of 25 years on 31st July of the current calendar year. Participation in the above mentioned games and sports must not be earlier than three years before the academic session in which admission is sought.

(B) ART / CULTURE: Seats reserved: 2 Nos.

Eligibility: Proficiency in Fine Arts or Performing Arts, as evidenced by participation at the recognised Regional / National level competitions representing the State of Assam.



(C) LITERARY:

One seat in the M.A. in Assamese programme for the candidate having certificate of winning award / prizes in literary competitions of National Level or having standard published work.

(D) N.C.C.:

One seat reserved for the NCC candidates representing the State of Assam in the Republic Day Parade in New Delhi or having N.C.C. 'C' Certificate.

(E) N.S.S.:

One seat reserved for the N.S.S. volunteers who participated in Republic Day Parade at New Delhi or participated in at least one national level N.S.S. camp.

A relaxation of 5% of marks in the eligibility norms shall be allowed to the candidates considered for admission under the reservation categories.

NOTE: Ragging in any form is strictly prohibited in the University. If any incident of ragging comes to the notice of the University administration, the same shall be dealt with as per rules. Students involved in ragging may be expelled or handed over to the police, if necessary.
