- The B.A. (Major) Programmes (Under Choice Based Credit System) is offered in the subjects-Education, English and Sociology. The B.A. Programmes comprises of 6 (Six) semesters. The Department offers Core courses, Ability Enhancement Compulsory Course (AECC), Generic Elective (GE), Skill Enhancement Course (SEC) and Discipline Specific Elective (DSE) courses for all the subjects.
- Eligibility for Admission to B.A. (Major) Programmes: A student who passed the Higher Secondary (10+2) Examination of the Assam Higher Secondary Education Council, or any equivalent examination recognised as such by the University shall be eligible for admission to the First Semester of the Six Semester B.A. (Major) programme.
- Intake: 40 Nos.

# 6. <u>DEPARTMENT AT GUWAHATI CAMPUS OFFERING UG PROGRAMME:</u>

#### • DEPARTMENT OF PERFORMING ARTS:

The B.P.A. (Bachelor of Performing Arts): (Modular) is a three year (six semester) Bachelor Programme in Performing Arts on Modular Basis, at three levels—Certificate, Diploma and Degree has started w.e.f. the academic session 2018-19. The students enrolled in this programme shall have option to leave the programme after one year and subject to successful completion and passing the examinations he/she shall be awarded a Certificate by the University. Similarly, if a student want to leave the programme after successful completion of the second year and passes the examinations upto Fourth Semester he/she shall be eligible to receive a Diploma from

the University. On successful completion and passing out the examinations of the Sixth Semester, he/she shall be awarded B.P.A. degree.

- Eligibility for Admission: (i) Higher Secondary (10+2) Examination passed in any stream conducted by the Assam Higher Secondary Education Council, or an equivalent examination, and (ii) adequate experience in Performing Arts. The candidates for admission shall be selected through an interview.
- **Intake:** 40 Nos.
- Examination and Evaluation: Evaluation shall be done one a continuous basis. 40% marks shall be for Internal Assessment and 60% for End Semester Examination.

# ADMISSION PROCEDURE

#### 1. ONLINE APPLICATION PROCUDURE:

Interest candidates may **apply online** by following steps given below:

- (iii) Click the banner "Student login"
- (iv) Follow the instructions mentioned in Student login page.

#### 2. SELECTION PROCEDURE:

Selection of candidates for admission shall be made on merit basis.

The list of selected candidates shall be put on the Notice Board of the University and the University's website: **www.mssv.ac.in**. The candidates may be called for interview on the date and venue to be decided by the University.

Selected candidates shall have to get themselves admitted on the date & time as specified by the University on payment of the prescribed fee, failing which selection for admission shall automatically get cancelled.

### 3. WAITING LIST:

A waiting list, programme-wise, of the candidates shall be prepared. Candidates in Waiting List may also be called for interview along with the provisionally selected candidates. Vacant seats, if any, shall be filled up from the candidates in the Waiting List. No student from the Waiting List shall, however, be admitted to any programme after 15 days from the date of commencement of classes in a Semester/Session.

#### 4. <u>CANCELLATION OF ADMISSION:</u>

- (i) A candidate shall forfeit his/her seat, if admission is not taken on the specified date.
- (ii) A student shall also forfeit the seat, if he/she fails to attend classes without valid ground and permission of the Head of the Department concerned for **consecutive**15 (fifteen) days from the date of commencement of class.
- (iii) The name of the student shall also be struck off the Rolls of the University, if he/she is found admitted to other University / Institution during the academic session in which he/she is admitted in the University.

#### 5. ADMISSION TO NEXT HIGHER SEMESTER/CLASS:

Students of all the programmes on completion of a Semester shall be admitted to next higher Semester/Class on payment of the dues within the prescribed period. They must produce the official receipt of the payment of the dues to the respective Head of the Department for record and to get their names registered in the Department.

#### **6. ATTENDANCE:**

All students shall attend a minimum of 85% of the total number of classes held. Under special circumstances if the percentage of attendance falls below 85% but above 75%, the student may be considered for giving permission to appear in the End Semester Examination on payment of the prescribed fine.

### 7. RESERVATION AND RELAXATION FOR ADMISSION:

# (i) Statutory Reservation:

Scheduled Caste (S.C.) : 7%
Scheduled Tribes, Plains (S.T.P.) : 10%
Scheduled Tribes, Hills (S.T.H.) : 5%
OBC / MOBC : 15%

EWS : 10% from Unreserved.

#### NOTE:

For consideration of admission under reserved categories, Caste Certificates countersigned by the Deputy Commissioner of the district concerned must be produced.

# (ii) Differently Abled (Physically handicapped):

- 3% of the total seats in each subject/programme shall be reserved for the differently abled candidates.
- Candidates applying for admission under this category of reservation must submit Medical Certificate issued by the Joint Director of Health Services of the district concerned.
- Candidates with negligible deficiency shall not be considered for admission under this category of reservation.

#### (iii) Extra Curricular Activities:

#### (A) SPORTS:

A total of three seats for all the programmes have been reserved for the candidates having proficiency in Extra Curricular activities as shown below. He/she must have represented the State of Assam in any one of the games conducted by the National Sports Federation or Association of Indian Universities (AIU), New Delhi as recognised by the Sports Authority of India (SAI) / Ministry of Human Resource Development, Govt. of India. (1) Athletics (2) Badminton (3) Cricket (4) Football (5) Table Tennis (6) Weight Lifting and Best Physique (7) Volley Ball. The candidates under this category must be below the age of 25 years on 31<sup>st</sup> July of the current calendar year. Participation in the above mentioned games and sports must not be earlier than three years before the academic session in which admission is sought.

#### **(B)** ART / CULTURE: Seats reserved: 2 Nos.

**Eligibility:** Proficiency in Fine Arts or Performing Arts, as evidenced by participation at the recognised Regional / National level competitions representing the State of Assam.

### (C) LITERARY:

One seat in the M.A. in Assamese programme for the candidate having certificate of winning award / prizes in literary competitions of National Level or having standard published work.

### **(D) N.C.C.:**

One seat reserved for the NCC candidates representing the State of Assam in the Republic Day Parade in New Delhi or having N.C.C. 'C' Certificate.

# (E) N.S.S.:

One seat reserved for the N.S.S. volunteers who participated in Republic Day Parade at New Delhi, participated in at least one national level N.S.S. camp.

A relaxation of 5% of marks in the eligibility norms shall be allowed to the candidates considered for admission under the reservation categories.

NOTE: Ragging in any form is strictly prohibited in the University. If any incident of ragging comes to the notice of the University administration, the same shall be dealt with as per rules. Students involved in ragging may be expelled or handed over to the police, if necessary.
